With an agreement (stipulation) - \$90.00 (+ service fees if the court serves).

Filing and service fees must be paid upon filing unless an Application to Waive Filing Fees and Service Costs ([form 600-00228](#)) is filed and granted.

**Stipulations must be approved by the court.**

If the case becomes contested, an additional filing fee must be paid to the court before it issues a final order.

**Service:**

The Court is responsible for making sure the other party receives a copy of the filed documents if there are minor children. Since the court executes service there is an extra service fee that is required to be paid at the time of filing.

There are a few ways to serve the other person in the case that is acceptable to the court: First Class Mail with Notice of Action and Request for Waiver of Service of Summons ([form 400-00820](#)) (service fee is \$3.00), Certified Mail (service fee is \$18.50), Personal Service by sheriff, and Service by publication (fee varies-contact court staff for details). Service will be attempted based on the contact information you have provided, and the appropriate service fee paid to the court.
