PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER

Based upon the agreement of the parties, the following deadlines shall apply in the above-referenced matter:

Exchange the names and addresses of all persons having knowledge of relevant facts and/or of witnesses	September 13, 2024
Serve requests for production of documents and evidence	December 20, 2024
Respond to requests for production of documents and evidence	January 24, 2025
Disclose expert witnesses	February 21, 2025
Disclose rebuttal expert witnesses	April 11, 2025
Take depositions	May 9, 2025
Complete discovery, including discovery-related motions	May 23, 2025
File motions to amend the petition of misconduct	March 7, 2025
File objections to the hearing panel conducting the merits hearing remotely by video conferencing	April 11, 2025
File pre-hearing motions, including motions <i>in limine</i>	June 20, 2025
File a witness list identifying the witnesses the party anticipates calling to testify at the merits hearing, together with a brief summary of each witness's anticipated testimony and an estimate of the amount of time needed for direct examination, and an exhibit list identifying the exhibits the party anticipates presenting at the merits hearing, together with a representation as to whether or not the opposing party stipulates to each exhibit's authenticity or admissibility or both.	June 27, 2025

This matter shall be ready for a two-day merits hearing no later than July 11, 2025.
