- 1. YOU MAY SEEK REVIEW OF THE IMPOSITION OF THE SUSPENSION PURSUANT TO RULE 75 OF THE VERMONT RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE. Rule 75 review is filed in the Civil Division of the Vermont Superior Court in the County where you were issued the Notice of Violation.**
- 2. If you do not successfully complete the Youth Substance Awareness Safety Program for the underlying violation, you will receive credit for the elapsed period of a suspension served pursuant to this Notice against any suspension imposed by 7 V.S.A. section 656(b)(3)(A).**

3. During the period of the suspension issued pursuant to this Notice, you may operate a motor vehicle if issued an ignition interlock restricted driver's license or certificate in accordance with 23 V.S.A. § 1213.
4. The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles will issue a Notice of Reinstatement upon successful completion of the suspension.
5. The issuance of this Notice of Suspension and related Notice of Violation does not bar prosecution for any crime, including a prosecution under 23 V.S.A. § 1201.
